June 18, 2024

I. Call to Order

Julie White called the meeting to order at 6:00 pm.

IV. Agenda - review and modify

The agenda was reviewed with one addition to New Business: Berm on Ridgecrest Connector. After addition the agenda was adopted by consensus.

V. Adoption of Minutes

The minutes of the April meeting were reviewed with changes made to indicate the feasibility study is being conducted by Fonta Flora, not Ridgecrest. After the change, the minutes were adopted by consensus.

VI. Old Business

a. Update on Trails & Greenways Committee

Underpass improvements at the tunnel connecting Veteran's Park to the Community Garden have been abandoned due to cost. Julie White will reach out to Josh Harrold for the new improvement plan.

b. Update on Feasibility Study on Town Properties

In July Equinox Environmental will start feasibility studies, working with different focus groups online. Our commission will be in the recreation focus group.

c. Follow-up on Parking at Lake

The Town Council voted to add one sign, that will encompass several spots, to reserve senior parking during the recommended hours. They are looking into enforcement options. No movement on getting a path from the pavilion parking lot to walk to the pool.

d. Follow-up on Plans for Blue Ridge Road

Lisa Raleigh clarified with Jennifer Tipton who she should contact on town staff to understand where the application to MPO stands for a complete street on Blue Ridge Road, and the submission history. She will use this information to engage with MPO about how to have the request perform better.

e. Vacancies on Commission

Julie motioned to recommend Julie White and Karen Neal for this commission, Kyle seconded and the motion was passed.
