V. NEW BUSINESS

1. 116 Cherry Street Sign Review

The owner of the new yoga studio opening at 116 Cherry Street has provided a rendering of the sign she would like to place on the building. The sign is proposed to be placed on the rear of the building facing the parking lot behind the Black Mountain Center for the Arts. The sign will be metal die-cut letters and logo and will be placed directly on the wall. Staff will confirm the size that was noted on the application. After reviewing the sign design principles in the guidelines, the commission voted 3-1 to approve the sign, with Debi Norman voting against.

2. Staff Reviews

Russell Cate went over the proposed sign for Krista Anne's on West State Street. The sign is just a face change replacement and was reviewed and approved by Mr. Cate.

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3. Grant Options

Jennifer Tipton reached out to the state for types of projects that could be considered for a CLG grant. Some of the projects that could potentially be eligible include:

- Architectural and archaeological surveys
- Nomination of eligible districts and properties to the National Register of Historic Places
- Update design standards
- Preservation plans
- Public education programs (including archaeological)
- Restoration of local government or non-profit owned National Register-listed properties

Ms. Tipton will try and schedule the employees from the state to participate virtually at the next meeting to discuss these ideas further.
