Black Mountain Town Council held their special meeting agenda on Wednesday, February 25, 2026, at 3:00 PM in the Council Chambers of Town Hall, 160 Midland Avenue, Black Mountain, NC 28711.

## 1. CALL TO ORDER

Mayor C. Michael Sobol called the special meeting to order at 3:01 p.m. with the following members in attendance: Mayor C. Michael Sobol, Vice Mayor Archie Pertiller, Council Member Alice Berry, Council Member Pam King, Council Member Ryan Stone. *Council Member Doug Hay was absent.*

## 2. NEW BUSINESS

### 2.A. Consideration of Budget Amendment- Police Department.

This budget amendment is for the BMPD donation contribution line. The original approved budget amount was \$42,000. Due to additional donations received throughout the year, the department requests to increase this line, 235-4510-55023, by \$30,308.18 (from line 235-0000-47070), bringing the total budget to \$72,308.18. This adjustment will be used to cover fees related to the Tactical Mindset conference and other community outreach projects.

**2.B. Short-Term Repairs of Concession Stand at Veterans Park for Baseball Season.**

Interim Town Manager Richard Hicks stated short-term repairs to the existing concession stand need to be performed in order to be ready for the upcoming baseball season games at Veterans Park. Mr. Hicks explained that staff should be able to complete most of the short-term repairs to get the concession stand operational for the baseball season. If work remains that would be of cost to the Town, it would be brought back before Council to authorize those repairs.

*Vice Mayor Archie Pertiller made a motion to authorize staff to make these short-term repairs to the concession stand at Veterans Park, and for any additional repairs that staff cannot complete, that would incur costs, to be brought back before Council for authorization. A vote of 4-0 in favor. Council Member Doug Hay was absent.*



**4. ADJOURNMENT**


Council returned from closed session at 4:55 p.m.
